## **XGS-PON Upgrade Project**

Some components ordered from Calix arrived broken, and obtaining a Return Merchandise Authorization has been a struggle.

## **BNG Upgrade Project**

GlgabitNow has made some progress toward migrating early pilot customers to the BNG, but details are unknown to the Board at this time.

The Board asked GigabitNow to update the upgrade planned schedule to reflect the current status and commissioning challenges.
